Slavery in the Pee Dee Region

Objective

Students will understand the life of a typical slave in the Pee Dee region of South Carolina.

Procedures

- 1. Students will read and discuss "Plantations and Slave Life in the Pee Dee" pages 20-31 from <u>Indians</u>, <u>Slaves</u>, and <u>Freedom in the Pee Dee Region of South Carolina</u> by Debi Hacker and Michael Finkley.
- 2. Students will complete a Venn diagram comparing and contrasting the life of the plantation owner and the slaves using housing, food, and personal belongings as a basis of comparison.
- 3. Students will write an essay based on their Venn diagrams using the writing process.

Evaluation

Essays will be graded using the fifteen point rubric developed by the state department of education.
